

Sec. 23-4. Removal of snow and ice from sidewalks by owners of abutting property.

1. The occupant of any premises, or the owner of any unoccupied premises, shall keep the sidewalks in front of, or adjacent to such premises cleared, so far as is practicable and reasonable, from snow and ice to facilitate pedestrian use. Where there are no sidewalks, the occupant or owner as aforementioned, is required to clear a path free from snow and ice where a sidewalk would otherwise be, to facilitate pedestrian use. Whenever any snow or ice has fallen or accumulated it shall be cleared within twelve (12) hours after it has fallen or accumulated.
